

CURRENT SITUATION IN UKRAINE

- FULL-SCALE WAR WITH ON GROUND FIGHTS IN EAST AND SOUTH, AND ROCKET ATTACKS IN ALMOST ALL REGIONS
- FARMERS DECREASED THE SOWN AREAS BY 20% IN 2022, AND BY AT LEAST 10% IN 2023
- CRITICAL INFRASTRUCTURE (ENERGY, TRANSPORT ETC.)
 IS STILL UNDER THE ATTACKS
- ALMOST 4 MLN. PEOPLE ARE INTERNALLY DISPLACED PLUS OVER 6.5 MLN. ARE REFUGEES



DAMAGE AND LOSSES: LATEST ESTIMATIONS BY WORLD BANK (DEC 2023)



RAPID DAMAGE AND NEEDS ASSESSMENT:

- DIRECT DAMAGE US\$152 BILLION
- RECOVERY AND
 RECONSTRUCTION NEEDS US\$486 BILLION

MOSTLY IMPACTED SECTORS:

- HOUSING
- TRANSPORT
- INFRASTRUCTURE
- AGRICULTURE
- ENERGY

DAMAGE AND LOSSES IN AGRICULTURE: US\$80.1 BILLION

- DIRECT DAMAGE US\$10.3 BILLION:
 - MACHINERY AND EQUIPMENT DAMAGE 57%
 - STOLEN INPUTS AND OUTPUTS 18%
 - DAMAGED STORAGE FACILITIES 18%
- MOSTLY AFFECTED REGIONS:
 - LUHANSKA
 - ZAPORIZKA
 - KHERSONSKA OBLAST







DAMAGE AND LOSSES IN AGRICULTURE: ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT

- DAMAGE TO UKRAINE'S IRRIGATION AND WATER RESOURCE - US\$ 740.2 MILLION:
- ON-FARM INFRASTRUCTURE DAMAGE – 48.5%
- KAKHOVKA DAM 48%

LOSSES IN THE I&D SECTOR - US\$716.8 MILLION

CONSEQUENCES:


- PROBLEMS WITH WATER AVAILABILITY

- RURAL ECONOMIES DEPRESSION

 ESTIMATED RECOVERY NEEDS FOR THE DEMINING AND SOIL HEALTH RESTORATION

US\$ 15 BILLION

MANY ISSUES:

- FARMLAND EXPOSED TO LANDMINES RANGE FROM 470,000 HECTARES TO 2.5 MILLION HECTARES (ESTIMATIONS!)
- UNEXPLODED SHELLS IN MANY FIELDS
- INCREASED TOXICITY AND REDUCED DIVERSITY OF MICROORGANISMS
- CHANGING WATER TABLE'S DEPTH, DEPRIVING VEGETATION
